

Production Plan During COVID-19 Pandemic - Summary

1. This Production Safety Plan Summary is posted at all locations.
2. A copy of the detailed Production Safety Plan is available at all locations.
3. All recommended signage has been posted throughout the workplace.
4. All artists, workers, volunteers and contractors undergo active screening conducted by Blyth Festival using the provincial screening tool.
5. All patrons undergo passive screening through signage and pre-performance communications.
6. Anyone who fails screening does not enter the workplace and advised to seek medical direction and/or assessment.
7. Anyone who displays symptoms in the workplace shall be directed to return home, self-isolate and seek medical attention.
8. Outdoor space is used whenever possible.
9. All artists, workers, volunteers, professional visitors, and patrons follow physical distancing guidelines.
10. Front of House personnel shall monitor and prevent crowding of patrons.
11. All amenities available to the public have been identified, and are cleaned and disinfected (using a disinfectant with a drug identification number) as necessary to maintain a sanitary condition.
12. Hand and respiratory hygiene practices have been reviewed.
13. Hand sanitizer stations have been placed throughout the workplace.
14. Hand sinks are stocked with necessary supplies.
15. All patrons are shall wear masks or face coverings that cover mouth nose and chin in all indoor areas, and are requested to wear masks or face coverings in all outdoor areas.
16. All artists, workers, and volunteers who are not separated by a plexiglass or some other impermeable barrier and who may come within 2 meters of another person shall wear masks or face coverings covering their eyes, noses, and mouths.
17. All workers and volunteers who may come into contact with members of the public who are not wearing a mask or face covering shall wear personal protective equipment.
18. All artists, workers, and volunteers are trained in the Production Safety Plan and Pandemic Protocols, including personal protective equipment requirements, screening, not attending work when ill, and physical distancing.
